## BIOGRAPHY:

Malevolent Creation are back to blast and grind their back into the extreme metal game. They've influenced countless younger bands since their inception in 1987 and they show no signs of slowing down on their eleventh studio album. These death metal veterans have honed their skills to brutal perfection. It's no wonder why bands like Slipknot have cited this band as a major influence over the years. As mastermind Phil Fasciana sums it up, „If you're too slow, you've got to go.“ The band are notorious as ever, never allowing the revolving door of musicians to affect the power and skill of the music they're known for. Lineup changes aside, they are pumped and ready to go with warm-up headlining dates this July (with Gigan as support) straight into a direct supporting slot for the almighty Exodus this August/September!
